

Registration for Rising V Form

General instructions:

Please meet with each of your advisees individually. You, not your advisee, will complete and sign the registration form. **Do NOT allow your advisees to leave your meeting with the registration sheet.** Parents have received a copy of registration form which includes the student's sectioning. It is recommended that students pencil in those courses they would like to take in their senior year. This will allow them to plan ahead and take any prerequisite courses during their junior year. They are in no way committed to taking these classes.

Required Courses

V Form students should register for **5** courses. Each student is required to take English, Mathematics, Science, and History. The course titles on the student registration sheet indicate the particular section level recommended by the current teacher. These sections cannot be changed without approval of the department chair. Should students wish to change their section level, they must contact the appropriate department chair.

Foreign Language Requirement:

Students must complete Level 3 of a Foreign Language to fulfill graduation requirements. Although most students complete Level 3 as a sophomore, several students complete this requirement during their junior year. Please check to make sure your advisees have completed this requirement.

Junior Electives

Foreign Language:

If a student wishes to continue study in Foreign Language, leave the language recommendation as it is. If they are choosing to continue, but as a 6th course request, cross out the recommendation and copy it into the Additional Course Request box. Students may also begin study of a second language (at Level 1). The options are: *Spanish 1, French 1, or Latin 1.*

Arts:

Each student must satisfy an Arts requirement for graduation by completing an Arts course in either the 11th or 12th grade year. Students should refer to the 2005-2006 Course Catalogue to select this elective. If it is one of their top 5 choices, write the name of the course in the 11th grade Arts box. If it is to be a 6th (or 7th) course request write the name of the course in the Additional Course Requests box.

The History Delay Option

Students must complete *US History* to graduate. Some students concerned about the additional academic challenges of the junior year may delay completing US History until their 12th grade year. For example, a student could register for *English, Precalculus Biology, French 4* and *Acting I*. This student must register for *US History* as a senior. Please exercise this option prudently; delaying this requirement usually restricts freedom in the senior year.

Additional Courses

Rising V Form students should register for 5 courses. If students wish to request an additional course, they must indicate their choice in the Additional Course Requests box. For example, if a student wants to register for *Photography* as a sixth course, he/she should write "*Photography*" in the *Additional Course Requests* box. Courses selected in this box will be assumed to be of lower priority to the student. Requests for courses beyond the standard 5 are subject to review by the Dean and Academic Review Committee.
